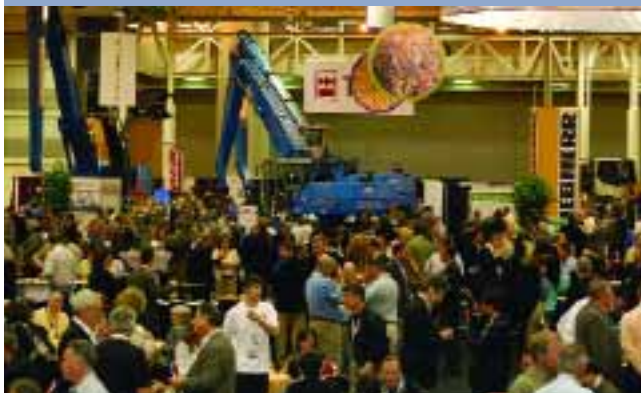

## DISTINGUISHED SPEAKER

### **Former President Bill Clinton**

**Founder, William J. Clinton Foundation  
42nd President of the United States**



William Jefferson Clinton was the first Democratic president in six decades to be elected twice – first in 1992 and then in 1996. Under his leadership, the country enjoyed the strongest economy in a

generation and the longest economic expansion in U.S. history, including the creation of more than 22 million jobs.

After leaving the White House, President Clinton established the William J. Clinton Foundation with the mission to strengthen the capacity of people in the United States and throughout the world to meet the challenges of global interdependence. Today the Foundation has 800 staff and volunteers around the world working to improve lives through several initiatives, including the Clinton HIV/AIDS Initiative which is helping 1.4 million people living with HIV/AIDS access lifesaving drugs. As a project of the Foundation, the Clinton Global Initiative brings together global leaders to devise and implement innovative solutions to some of the world's most pressing issues. In the U.S., the Foundation is

working to combat the alarming rise in childhood obesity, and is helping individuals and families succeed and small businesses grow.

In addition his Foundation work, President Clinton has joined with former President George H.W. Bush three times – after the 2004 tsunami in South Asia, Hurricane Katrina in 2005, and Hurricane Ike in 2008 – to help raise money for recovery efforts.

Michael Josephson is president and founder of the Los Angeles-based Josephson Institute, a nonprofit organization devoted to improving the ethical quality of society by changing personal decision

making and behavior. In 1995, Josephson received the America's award from President Ronald Reagan. ## Mandalay Bay Resort & Casino

Mandalay Bay Resort & Casino, site of ISRI's 2009 convention, comprises two hotels, both centrally located off the 135,000-square-foot casino and a short walk through the property to the Mandalay Bay Convention Center.
